The fair will not be as spectacular as in the capital of Lithuania, nonetheless on that day The Old Market Square in Poznań will turn into the colorful market of regional food and handicraft.

Also, at 11:30 am under the arcades of the historical Town Hall we will encounter members of the Jagiełło dynasty.
