





Genius Loci Archaeological Reserve

The park presents relics of the early-Piast Middle Ages town fortifications dating back to the 10th Century, and the remains of the Renaissance wall that once surrounded the Cathedral Island. In the state-of-the-art audio-visual hall the visitors can follow through the history of the settlement on the Cathedral Island, which began in the 10th century.

Novel exposition solutions, factual content based on a system of multimedia visualisations and holographic presentations as well as a 3D technology film are just some ventures through which the subject of beginnings of early Polish statehood and the city of Poznań is introduced. Apart from sightseeing opportunities, the Reserve also organises workshops, learning activities, temporary displays, concerts and cultural events.
