During the festival brand new films are presented, along with the forgotten classics. This year, 3765 films from 123 countries were submitted for the competition, 50 feature films and 100 short films were chosen for the main competition. All will compete for the Golden Goats and special prizes from from the youth and children jury. Altough presented films are mostly premieres, some have already been noticed in the world, such as: *Miss Impossible* (Special Distinction - Generation K-Plus, Berlinale 2016 European Film Award 2016 in category Young Audience Award) and *My name is Zuchinni* (Audience Award and the Award for the best feature film at the Annecy Festival 2016; Audience Award San Sebastian 2016; Audience Award Warsaw Film Festival).
